

August 20, 2024, Primary Election Public Inspection Policy (101.572(2))

Access to Ballot Materials - Those qualified to receive access to ballot materials pursuant to 101.572(2), Florida Statutes, may request an appointment to review ballot materials.

- 1. Requests must be made at least 48 hours (2 days) in advance of requested appointment slot (not including weekends and holidays) and must include specific materials to which the requestor would like access. Please email <u>candidates@votepalmbeach.gov</u>, or call 561-656-6208 to request an appointment.
- 2. Participants must submit their completed qualification documents <u>prior</u> to booking an appointment.
 - a. Request to Review Ballot Materials Form
- 3. Participants requesting an appointment will receive a booking link via email once their qualification form has been verified.
- 4. Each appointment duration is a 30-minute window (a 15-minute window on Election Day). Inspection will begin promptly at the scheduled time and will end at its scheduled end time. No additional time will be allotted regardless of arrival time or other delays not caused by our office.
- 5. Participants will be given a 5-minute post processing window to turn in all paperwork.
- 6. Only 1 person on behalf of a given candidate, political party, or political committee is permitted to review or inspect ballot materials per day per appointment.
- 7. Cell phones must be put away during inspection. No photos or videos of signatures or ballots are permitted.
- 8. The Supervisor of the Elections office may cancel, change, or add appointments during the election cycle. A participant with a confirmed appointment that is cancelled or changed will receive an email notification.
